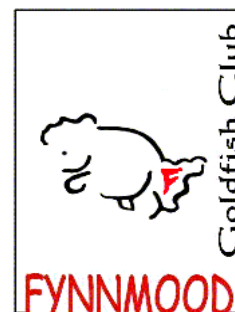

**GOLDFISH COMPETITION**

**CATEGORIES**

**Category 1 - Ranchu (any colour)**

- Class A – Ranchu – Junior (10-14cm)
- Class B – Ranchu – Senior (>14cm)

**Category 2 – Oranda (Long Tail – any colour)**

- Class A – Oranda – Junior (12-16cm)
- Class B – Oranda – Senior (>16cm)

**Category 3 – Ryukin (Any tail/colour)**

- Class A – Ryukin – Junior (Short Tail 10-14cm & Long Tail 12-16cm)
- Class B – Ryukin – Senior (Short Tail >14cm & Long Tail >16cm)

**Category 4 – Open (Any varieties except above stated class)**

- Class A/B – Open size (>12cm)
- Size measurement of fish is determined from tip of mouth to tip of caudal [tail] fins.

<b>PRIZE</b>	<b>ENTRY FEE</b>
<p>Handsome prizes will be awarded to top three positions of each category.</p> <p>Prize must be collected personally during the prize presentation date. Failure to do so without any reason may result in forfeit of prize.</p>	<p>Entry fee - \$25 per fish.</p>

## GOLDFISH – Judging and Health requirement

CRITERIA	DESCRIPTION
<b>Body shape</b>	Proportionate and symmetrical, without deformed (bulges or depressions)
<b>Body size</b>	Accordingly to the class restriction (bigger fish will be added advantage)
<b>Colour</b>	Brilliant and attractive (Rare colour is added advantage)
<b>Department</b>	Fish must strike a balance when swimming and horizontally when stationary.
<b>Eyes / Mouth</b>	Clear eyes, not cloudy / upper and lower jaws should be properly aligned
<b>Fins</b>	Dorsal fin should be alert (standing); Single or double Anal fins is accepted Pectoral and pelvic fins must be paired and no bend; Caudal (tail) must be well spread with the shoulder tail (lower lobes) covering the anal fins when viewing from the side.
<b>Gill covers</b>	Not overly covered the gills or exposing the gill.
<b>Health</b>	Fish is healthy with no sign of whitespot, fin rot, anchorworms, etc
<b>Hood/Wen</b>	Head growth should be considerable uniform and balance with its body size.
<b>Scales</b>	Neatly layered, shiny, uniform and complete

Fishes will be disqualified if the following is observed: Deformity, Disease, Incorrect categorization, Cosmetic alteration.

### Judging Method- two rounds of judging

#### **First Round (Judge's Preference)**

Judges will each pick fishes from each category base on their personal preferences and likings for their definition for good champion fish. After comparison on the judges' preference of fishes on each category, the fishes that are selected based upon majority of the judges' agreement will go for second round.

#### **Second Round (Ranking System)**

These fishes selected from first round will be judged base on the uniqueness of individual varieties and hence through this Ranking system, the first 3 position of each category will be selected.

'A' represents First priority, 'B' represents Second priority, 'C' represents Third priority ... .. respectively, etc.

## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Participants must submit full details as requested in the Entry Form for participation in the Competition; the acceptance of entries is subject to full payment of Entry Fees stipulated in the Entry Form (“Entry Fees”); Entries without payment will not be entertained; Entry fees are non-refundable.
2. In the event of overwhelming response, the Organizer based on “First Come First Serve” basis will accept entries on a selection process. Participants will be informed of their entry status.
3. All participants are advised to fast their fish 2-4 days prior to the bench in to prevent any complications to their fish; Fish will not be fed throughout the event and participants are not allowed to feed their fish during the event.
4. All fish must be brought to the competition venue for bench in, late bench in is not acceptable; During bench in, organizer reserves the right to reject any fish that is sick or injured.
5. Participant must transfer their competition fish into the allocated tank with the present & witness by the organizing committee.
6. Fish that have been bench in for competition may not be removed from the display tanks without valid reason and Organizer’s prior approval, until the stipulated bench out time on the last day of the event.
7. Each entry will be provided with a 2ft x 1 ft x 1 ft glass tank, aeration and filter for all entries. All special requests have to be indicated advance via application form.
8. The organizer will take best efforts to ensure the health and well-being of all participating fish during competition duration, it disclaims liability for any loss, mortality, injury, sickness and/or any form of damage/harm to the fish whatsoever to participating fish.
9. In the event that the competition is postponed, shortened or extended due to any cause whatsoever beyond the control of the Organizer, the Organizer shall not be held responsible for any loss sustained by the participant, directly or indirectly.
10. All participants are to collect their fish from the collection date and timing as stated in the entry form; Competition fish, which are not collected after the specified date and time, shall become the property of the Organizer.
11. Reputable Local & foreign judges have been invited to judge the Fish Competition. The decisions of the judges are final and no disputes will be entertained; No participants are allowed to enter the hall during judging.
